ORDER

This cause came on for consideration without oral argument on the following motion filed herein:

**MOTION: UNOPPOSED MOTION TO EXTEND DEADLINE TO FILE
MOTION FOR ATTORNEYS' FEES (Doc. No. 268)**

FILED: November 19, 2018

**THEREON it is ORDERED that the motion is GRANTED in part and
DENIED in part.**

In the Order Granting Plaintiffs' Motion for Preliminary Approval of Class Action Settlement ("Settlement Order"), the deadline for potential members of the Settlement Class to submit an objection to the proposed settlement is November 26, 2018. Doc. No. 264 ¶ 15. Plaintiffs cannot, at this late date, disrupt that schedule as they propose without causing prejudice

to class members who have been notified of the objection deadline. Thus, it is **ORDERED** as follows:

1. Plaintiffs shall file their motion for attorneys' fees no later than November 21, 2018, at noon Eastern Standard Time ("EST")¹. The motion must certify that counsel complied with Local Rule 3.01(g) in the manner required by the Case Management and Scheduling Order (Doc. No. 201, at 5-6) in a good faith effort to determine whether the motion is opposed.

2. The deadline for potential members of the Settlement Class to object to the proposed settlement, including the motion for attorneys' fees, is extended up to and including December 7, 2018. Potential Settlement Class members who wish to object must follow the procedure set forth in the Settlement Order. All objections must be postmarked on or before December 7, 2018.

3. No later than November 21, 2018, at 1:30 p.m. EST, Plaintiffs shall cause a copy of their motion for attorneys' fees and all documents filed in support of the motion to be posted on the class action settlement website, www.jeunessedistributorsettlement.com. See Doc. No. 259-2, at 12.

4. No later than November 21, 2018, at 1:30 p.m. Orlando time, Plaintiffs shall update the "Important Dates" section of the class action settlement website, www.jeunessedistributorsettlement.com, to reflect that objections to the proposed settlement must be postmarked on or before December 7, 2018.

5. No later than November 21, 2018, at 5:00 p.m. EST, Plaintiffs shall deliver via electronic mail the following to potential Settlement Class members for whom they have electronic mail addresses: (a) notice of their attorneys' fee motion as required by Fed. R. Civ. P. 23(h); and (b)

notice of the contents of this Order. The notice must inform the potential Settlement Class members that the deadline for objecting to the proposed settlement has been extended and that all objections must be postmarked on or before December 7, 2018.

6. For potential Settlement Class members for whom Plaintiffs do not have an electronic mail address, Plaintiffs shall cause notice to be sent by non-electronic means for receipt by those individuals no later than November 23, 2018, at noon in the time zone to which the notice is being sent. The notice must include: (a) notice of Plaintiffs' attorneys' fee motion as required by Fed. R. Civ. P. 23(h); and (b) notice of the contents of this Order. The notice must inform these potential Settlement Class members that the deadline for objecting to the proposed settlement has been extended and that all objections must be postmarked on or before December 7, 2018.

7. No later than November 23, 2018, Plaintiffs shall file a notice certifying that they have complied with these requirements.

8. Failure to comply with these requirements may result in the motion for attorneys' fees being denied.
